

Member Communication Claiming the Job Retention Scheme Bonus 12th October 2020

The government have now issued more information for Employer's who will be eligible to claim the Job Retention Scheme Bonus.

- This bonus, which is £1,000 for each employee, will be paid to employers for any previously furloughed workers they continue to employ from the end of the last claim period until 31 January 2021.
- To be eligible you must have paid any individual's for whom you submit a claim a minimum of £1560 between 6 November 2020 and 5 February 2021. (This is to prevent employers paying employees small amounts or providing no work to those on zero hours contracts and then claiming the bonus in respect of those employees)
- You will not be able to claim for any Employees who are working a period of notice as at 31st
 January 2021
- You do not have to pass any of the bonus on to the employee.
- You can still claim the bonus if you make a claim for that employee through the new Job Support Scheme
- You will have 6 weeks in which to claim the bonus between 15 February and 31 March 2021
